2. General Design Guidelines <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appropriate colors selected: background white; text black; banner solid or gradient filled • Banner includes standardized elements: title, team members' names, transparent CHS Magnet (left side) and Mean Machine (right side) logo • Figures and tables contain captions including one sentence summarizing main point of figure. Tables include titles and appropriately labeled axes. • Symmetry is achieved through balancing pictures, graphs, charts, and table in layout <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Represents a balance of ~ 50/50 (text:pictures)

1. Organizational Structure <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Content reflects the entire scope and sequence of the research process via major sections discussed in class. Titles may vary. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ ABSTRACT (overview of entire project) ○ MATERIALS AND METHODS (procedural steps and materials) ○ RESULTS (the data collected) ○ DISCUSSION (interpretation of results, including how this supports or not their hypothesis, limitations of their study, etc.) ○ CONCLUSION (addresses future possibilities and implications of their work; should include both a short and long term plan) ○ ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS (specific "thank yous") ○ REFERENCES (relevant sources, 2-3, cited in work) • Reads left to right, top to bottom, with easy flow 				
2. Content Guidelines and Principles <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Writing is succinct while communicating key points. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Bulleted lists are appropriate as well as <u>short</u> paragraphs. • Poster needs to be able to "stand alone" while not being text heavy.
